
DSTWG Meeting #22 14 Sep 2022

- Draft Joint Transition Plan Outline presented at the HCT/Donor meeting of 20 September and endorsed








Area-based coordination deep dive **East Anbar ABC:** Al Garma, Al-Khairat and Al Sijir Aug, 2022, <u>link</u>


