TORs for ABC and DSTWG

- Endorsed by DSTF on Apr 5 following multiple rounds of review

East Anbar ABC Focal Point

- UNHCR selected as 2nd focal point; Mercy Hands selected as 3rd focal point by DSTF

Call for new ABC members

- Application window closed by 17 April: results 55+ aspiring applicants

Transition

- Discussion between ICCG & DSTWG has started on modalities re the transitioning
- A series of meetings will take off to discuss further to reach agreement on steps forward



Housing & HLP

- Guidance note: HLP and HLP dispute mediation shared
- Guidance note: integration of informal sites in urban areas (forthcoming)

Facilitated Movement

- Objectives of the initial ToR completed.
- Brainstorming Workshop on Informal sites with ABC Mosul

- Presenting potential DS-related questions under DS discussion

Social Cohesion

- No update as of yet



- Kirkuk** After launch: inter-agency fact finding mission to Daquq planned for May.
- Sinjar** Deep-dive meeting conducted (focus on Tal Banat, Tal Qasab).
- Ba'aj** Support call for returnees from Syria, POA draft finalized.
- Mosul** Informal sites workshop, PoA under proof reading. Deep-dive meeting planned for May
- Diyala** ABC coordination in practice conducted. Next meeting- 9 May
- E Anbar** Additional focal Points (UNHCR + Mercy Hands confirmed). Deep Dive planned for 27 Apr Al-Garma District
- W Anbar** Coordination-in-practice (deep dive): Ana (Al Sagra & Rayhana) focus (26 Apr)
- SAD** ABC deep dive scheduled for 28 April



Overall analysis current PoAs (past + ongoing + select planned)

- Type of activities: Humanitarian (36%) – Dev/stabilization/peace (64%)
- Most in Hawiga (420 activities) – Least West Anbar (56 activities)
- Livelihood (31%); Housing (6.25%); No health interventions in Diyala
