DSTWG and ABC Updates

<u>National</u>

- Determine how/what humanitarian functions & expertise integrate in DS structures
- Cluster transition plans would be determining
- Transition of Hum. structures in DSTWG helps to:
 - Ensure technical. capacities & implementation are leveraged to contribute to achieving DS
 - <u>Retain</u> technical expertise + continuity for residual hum. needs; + links with long-term programming
 - Enable technical engagement with Gov. for capacity building and institutions strengthening

Sub-National (options and considerations)

- Integrate some cluster key functions in ABCs (areas uncovered remain un-addressed)
- Governorate-level transitional forum with an area-level focus (POAs for hotspot areas)
- Clarity needed what roles/responsibilities to be handed over (how reconcile with ABCs
- Resource needs for work of the ABCs, full-time focal points, IM support



- DSTWG asked REACH to add 3 DS-related questions to MCNA and expand assessment incl. more host community to give more comparative data amidst IDPs, Returnees and Host community.
- 1,300 members of the host community, approximately
- 10 districts: Erbil, Sumail, Sinjar, Al-Fallujah, Baquba, Tooz Khurmato, Al Rutba, Al-Baaj, Al-Hawiga, Al-Hatra (pending security)
- Rolls out by June 1st 2022
