












### Locations with blocked returns



## Security concerns



Security concerns were reported in 230 locations of no return

- Attacks by ISIL were the most prevalent concern, in 195 locations, most commonly in Hatra (44), Khanaqin (34) and Makhmur (29).
- Checkpoints controlled by armed groups were also identified as a security concern in 40 locations, most commonly in Al-Musayab, Babylon governorate and Dabes and Daquq in Kirkuk governorate.
- Unexploded ordnance and mines were a prevalent security concern in Makhmur district.

### Key reasons for no return





#### Residential destruction

- Identified in 130 locations
- Most common in Hatra (25), Khanaqin (25), Al-Ba'aj (23) and Makhmur (16).



### Poor security situation

- Identified in 128 locations
- Most common in Makhmur (26), Hatra (20), and Tuz Khurmatu (15).



#### Lack of services

- Identified in 109 locations
- Most common in: Hatra (23), Al-Ba'aj (13) and all locations of no return in Kirkuk governorate (23).



#### Blocked returns

- Identified in 42 locations
- Most common in Al-Hamdaniya and Telafar (12), as well as in Al-Musayab (13) and Baiji (3)

# Key reasons for no return (continued)





#### Drought

- Identified in 20 locations
- Most common in Hatra (15) and Al-Ba'aj (5)



#### Unexploded ordnance

- Identified in 18 locations,
- Most common in Al-Riyad in Al-Hawiga district and Markaz Daquq in Daquq district, but also in Mosul, Al-Ba'aj and Al-Muqdadiya.



### Tribal and ethno-religious tensions

- Identified in 16 locations
- Most common in seven locations in Al-Amerli in Tuz Khurmatu district.
