- Housing and HLP: Compensation Guidelines Endorsed and shared with ABCs. ToR of the Subgroup extended for a further 12 months
- Working group on the Livelihoods sub-group presented on the TOR and mandate. ToR finalised and circulated will be endorsed at the next DSTWG meeting and call for membership will follow.

DSTF updates (24 August)

- Funding concerns for organisations , fundraising for dedicated focal points, resource mobilization
- Discussion on the possibility of an ABC in Dahuk, existing structures in Dahuk, approach needed to be taken, discussions with authorities

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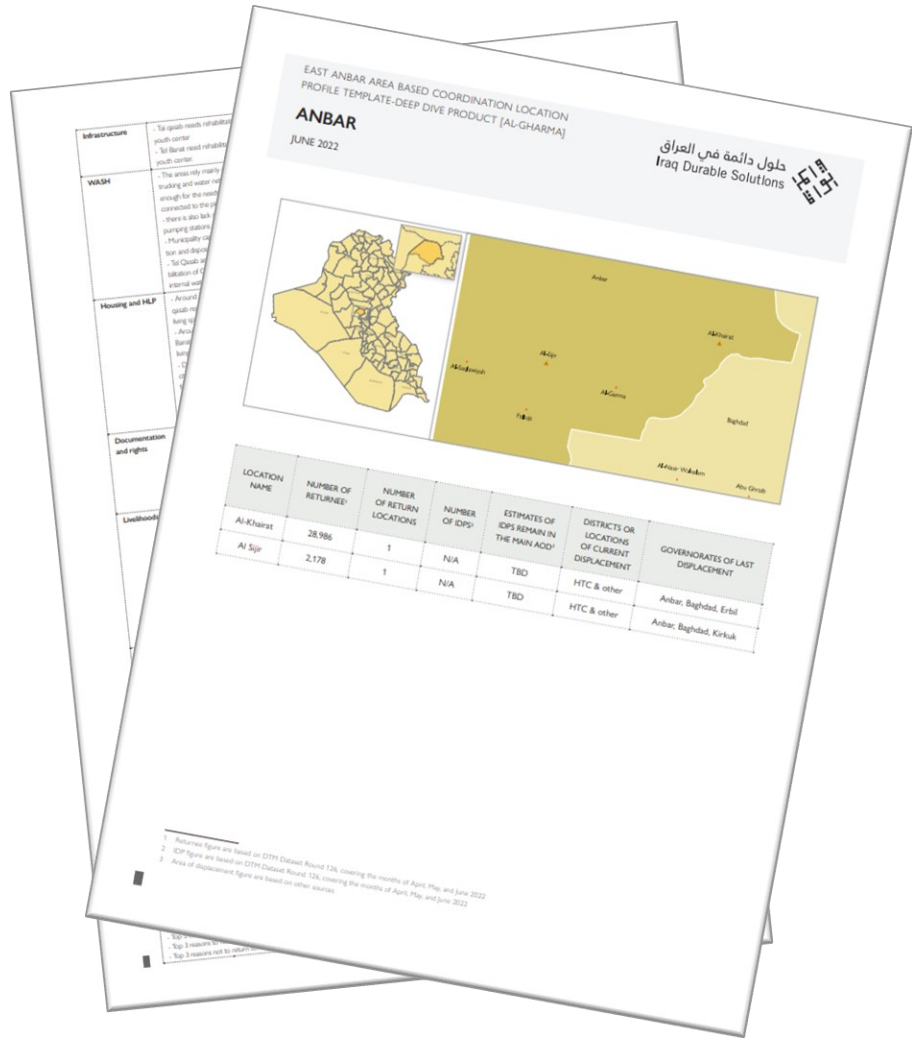

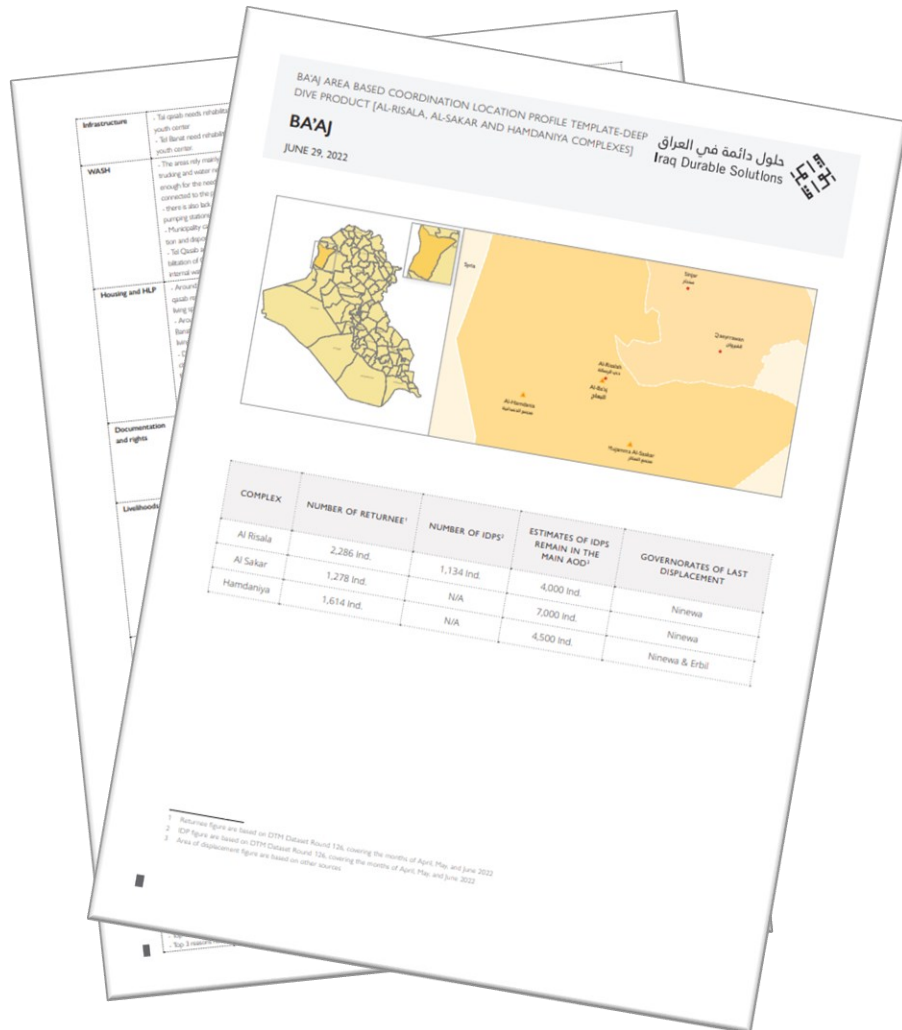

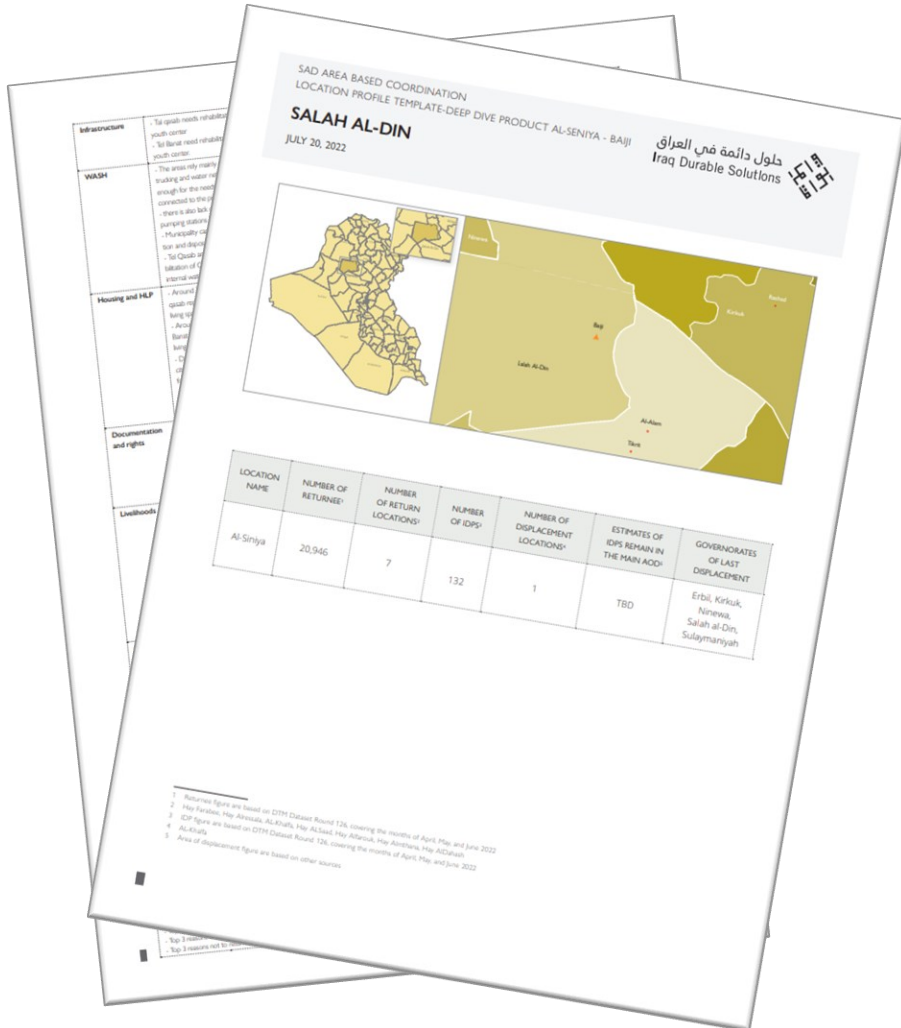
