





Do you feel safe when accessing aid or services?

mean: 4.1, n=1136














Do aid providers treat you with respect?




Do aid providers take your opinion into account when providing aid/services?





Do people in your community feel able to report instances of abuse or mistreatment by aid providers?




Do you know how to make suggestions or complaints about the aid/services you receive?





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




Do you feel informed about the kind of aid/services available to you?

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








Only 15% of affected people say that aid promotes self-reliance


