PRWG Overview



What is PRWG?

- ➤ The Peace and Reconciliation Working Group (PRWG) is a coordination mechanism that brings together on a monthly basis relevant NGOs, CSOs, international agencies and government representatives with reconciliation programs in Nineveh, with the aim to better coordinate activities and interventions.
- ➤ The PRWG is chaired by Sanad for peacebuilding org. under the sponsorship of GIZ.
- ➤ The purpose of this coordination mechanism is to reduce duplication, address geographical and thematic gaps, coordinate interventions, exchange researches, assessments, and knowledge of the field as well as contextual dynamics in Nineveh.

The PRWG includes:


- Secretariat/ Sanad for Peacebuilding Organization


Key Thematic Areas





Thematic Areas Mapping in Nineveh


