Update – Joint UN/Government Roadmap

What is the Roadmap

Joint initiative between Government of Iraq, including the KRG, and the UN to:

- i. Reaffirm that Iraqis remaining in displacement are of common concern to the Government and the international community.
- ii. Identify priority and actions that require converging efforts and cooperation from the Government and its partners to create a pathway for solutions to displacement.
- iii. Provide a framework to sustain and monitor the progress on solutions to internal displacement.

Status

- Under discussion with the Government since approximately Feb/March 2023
 - 8 November meeting of the Supreme Committee who approved the Roadmap in principle

Content of Roadmap

- 1. Deliver property compensation
- 2. Implement National Plan commitments to deliver safe housing
- 3. Simplify processes to enable persons who have been displaced to access housing, land and property documentation
- Provide essential infrastructure and services.
- 5. Assist families with political and security barriers to return
- 6. Distribute return and stabilization grants for all eligible persons
- 7. Remove remaining barriers to obtaining core civil documentation to all IDPs and returnees
- 8. Include all eligible IDPs in the Iraq national social protection scheme
- 9. Integrate all IDP and returnee children into local education systems

Role of the RWG in the Roadmap

The roadmap will be overseen by a Joint Technical Committee – which is a small group of Government and UN

Analysis and Advocacy

Assist families with political and security barriers to return
