DUHOK CAMP MOVEMENTS

July 2023

• **September:** 139 households - 721 Individuals

• *October:* 241 households – 1265 individuals

Returns were to Sinjar and areas around.

Reasons for return

IOM FVM program

Reuniting with their families and relatives

Their previous jobs are still available

Reverse Returns

• **September:** 8 households - 37 individuals

October: 21 households – 105 individuals

Out of Camp Returns

• October: 323 households

November 1st – Present: 405 households



ERBIL CAMP MOVEMENTS

Hassansham U2 Camp

■ **September:** 2 households – 21 individuals

October: 12 households –70 individuals

Most returns were to Ninawa

Hassansham U3 Camp

• **September:** 43 households – 229 individuals

October: 18 households –88 individuals

Most returns were to Ninawa and Kirkuk

Khazir Camp

• **September:** 62 households – 327 individuals

October: 27 households –138 individuals

Returns were to Ninawa

Out of Camp Returns

• October: 142 households returned to Mosul

• No returns from beginning of November to November 15, 2023 since they haven't gotten the approvals yet.



ERBIL CAMP MOVEMENTS

Debaga Camp

• **September:** 12 households – 74 individuals

• *October:* 17 households –91 individuals

Returns were to Makhmour, Qaraj and Hawija.

Bahrka Camp

September: 18 households – 96 individuals

October: 34 households – 159 individuals

Most returns were to Mosul and Baaj

Harsham Camp

• **September:** 6 households – 35 individuals

October: 3 households – 8 individuals

Most returns were to Baaj and Mosul



SULAYMANIAH CAMP MOVEMENTS

Current population: 212 families – 988 Individuals

Arbat Camp:

- 15 households 68 individuals returned to their areas of origin (Salah Al-Din)
- 5 households and 12 individuals returned to urban areas in Sulaymaniyah city after obtaining Asayish clearance
- MOMD provided the household with electrical appliances (1 Fridge, 1 Cooker, 1 TV set) and hired truck for the 15 families who returned to SAD.

Out of Camp Returns

• *October:* 2857 individuals

■ **November 1**st – **Present:** 1439 individuals

NOTE: Following a camp consolidation process, Qarato camp has closed and a camp consolidation process has begun between Ashti and Arbat Camp



Kirkuk Return Movements



KIRKUK MOVEMENTS

- 13 households from Kirkuk center return to the Hawija-Riyad subdistrict.
- The Housing and Property Compensation Committee is actively working on completing the necessary procedures, and the Compensation amounts have been delivered to 300 families during the past month, following the lists announced by the governorate.
- The areas that received most of the compensations are Hawija, Daquq and Dibis.
- The compensations vary from ten million to thirty million IQD.

Ninewa Field Update

Return to Shikhan Village- Telafar

- On Thursday 23 November the Governor Associate for NGOs and IDP Affairs, Mr. Ali
 Omar called an urgent meeting to flag recent returns to Shikhan Village
- According to the authorities around 20-30 HH have returned to the village in difficult conditions. The most urgent needs appear to be:
 - Food
 - NFI
 - Shelter rehabilitation
- The government will conduct an initial assessment of the village and a meeting will be held on Wednesday 29 November.
- Plans for a inter-agency assessment are underway pending further details from the authorities.


Compensation Committee

- 616 cases received the compensation during September-October 2023, total amount is 9 Billion IQD
- 799 cases received the compensation during September-October 2023, total amount is 9 Billion IQD
- 1141 cases received the compensation during October 2023, total amount is 12 Billion IQD
- 24 Billion IQD is allocated to cover 2177 Cases. The distribution will be completed by the end of November



Centre South Update





MoMD minister meets Opinion Commission

- Establishment of Joint Operations Room to follow up returns to Sinjar.
- Increase support to returning families, in-kind assistance, medical devices, return grants, etc.
- Find solutions to overcome obstacles.



MoMD Updates

- MoMD provides relief assistance to families displaced as a result desertification and drought in Basra.
- MoMD displacement plans to open phase 2 of MoMD project to track desertification and drought displacement.
- MoMD open registration of a project to grant loans to 100 female returning women from Ninawa, Anbar, SAD, Diyala and Kirkuk.



Return Grants

 MoMD released and distributed (IQD 21 billion) in the 29th round and (IQD 13 billion) in the 30th round of the return grants that targeted more than 23,000 families.

- 7 families to Markaz Heet

Other returns

- 12 Families return from AAF to Rumana and Qaim.
- 6 families return from J1 to Qaim and Rumana.
- 1 family returned from J1 to Al-Forat subdistrict in Heet.
- 2 families return from KRG to Ana.
- 8 Families return from Baghdad, Ramadi, and Falluja to Rawa and Ana.





Returns Updates

SAD

- 10 families returned from Suli camp to Al-Ajiliyah village
- 30 families returned from Jeddah camp to Shirqat, Baiji, Balad, Samarra, and Tikrit.
- As announced by MoMD, 111 HHs IDPs from the Arbat camp in Suli to their AoO in the Yathrib in Balad district

Diyala

- 20 families from Qoratoo Camp in Suli to Diyala, Saadiyah Subdistrict
- 10 families from Qoratoo Camp in Suli to Diyala, Muqdadiayh
