Objectives:

The meeting aimed to provide an update on the Sinjar online service map, a briefing on UNDP and IOM activities, and a follow-up on the action points from the previous meeting.

Main Points

The meeting was opened with a warm welcome from the IOM-FP. Key points highlighted:

- The secretary confirmed establishing the ([online service map.](#)) for the ABC activities in Baaj, Mosul, and Sinjar and shared it with the partners. All members were granted access, and partners were requested to update their activities by the 30th of September for analysis at the next meeting.
- Some partners did not respond to the Sinjar ABC secretary's email for contact information updates. All partners were urged to promptly inform the secretary of any changes to ensure an updated mailing list.
- Update from the Partners
 - NDP briefed on their Infrastructure activities in Sinjar, Sinuni, and Qaiyrawan as follows.
 - Reconstruction of the statistics building in Sinjar.
 - Building the Qaiyrawan Police Directorate, 90% is completed.
 - Rehabilitates the Andalas police in Sinuni, 90% is completed.
 - Improving access to water by installing street lighting with the solar system in the Dahola complex.
 - The UNDP withdrew Tal Al Qasab to implement the Lalish Cultural Center after it was confirmed that PKK started implementing activities there, UNDP is in the process of relocating the project to another location.

- Regarding reconstructing the Kogo Village, UNDP with IOM are working on the layout and waiting for the general plan of the village and the approvals of transferring ownership of the property from the Ministry of Agriculture to the Ministry of Municipality to start the project.
 - In addition to what has been mentioned, UNDP has livelihood projects in Sinjar and supports the recovery of the SME sector in Sinuni, and the vegetable market in Sinuni, and there is a plan to implement livelihood activities in Qahtaniyah, Talkef, and Talafer in 2024.
- IOM FP confirmed that IOM, UNDP, and UNOPS conducted a meeting, and they discussed their plans and interventions in Tal Azer and Seba Shehk to avoid any duplication or overlapping.
- The IOM supported 66 Families returning from Sardashty in Jabal Sinjar to Kharbat Qawal in Tal Azer. This was the last IOM supporting returnees program this month.
- ACF briefed on established last year Community Committees (CC) for disaster risk reduction, climate change, and water scarcity in Sinjar and Talafer. the committees received the required training, and the Sinjar ABC partners can use these committees for their activities if needed. Attached is the contact information for these CC.
