JCFs

- **Salahdeen:** JCF meeting conducted on 23 June. Co-chaired by the Deputy Governor and SEDO. Drinking Water Challenges in Salah Al-Din Amid Declining Tigris River Levels.
- **Ninewa:** JCF meeting conducted on 30 June, chaired by the Governor Assistant and UNICEF. Delayed Federal Budget: Housing and Construction in Sinjar. Presentation on IRC Activities in Mosul.
- **Diyala:** JCF meeting convened on 2nd July, co-chaired by Deputy governor and IOM. New return to villages of Jabbara sub-district. Only few organizations participated.
- **Anbar:** JCF meeting convened on 1st July, online meeting. Joint fact-finding mission preparation to Al Amal Reh. Center and some return areas in Anbar.
- **Kirkuk:** June meeting of JCF convened on 4th. July meeting will be convened once the Governor Assistant is back from abroad.

Sinjar ABC

- The monthly meeting conducted on 2nd July. Hybrid meeting, chaired by Ali Omer and IOM.
- Ali Omer briefed on Tapoo challenges for Gov allocated plots and the high level delegation visit to Sinjar.
- Presentation on the ongoing activities in Sinjar (77 implementing by 31 partners).

Project implementers: IOM, UNDP and UN Women, under guidance of the UN Resident Coordinator

in collaboration with Governor of Ninewa and Sinjar Reconstruction Fund

Project duration: April 2, 2025 – March 26, 2027

Project donor: UN Peacebuilding Fund

Project budget: 3 million USD

Project purpose

- Support peacebuilding, transitional justice and social cohesion in Sinjar, with focus on enhancing access to livelihoods, increasing access to mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS) services, expanded community understanding of, and participation in reconstruction of Sinjar.
- Strengthening women and youth leadership in above processes.
 - ❖ 1st Project Steering Committee meeting convened on July 9th in Baghdad.
 - ❖ The official launch of the project will be tomorrow in Ninewa by the RC and PM Advisor.
