Updates on Situation in Al-Khilaniyah Village

Re-opening of Al-Khilaniyah village in Muqdadiyah District:

- Announced re-opened in September 2024
- Total number of families is 523, including 155 households with security approval related marks.
- Out of the 155, 35 intend to return.
- Out of the remaining 368 families, 180 families have returned as of mid July 2025, around 40 households recently got security clearance, while another 40 are still under process.
- The IDPs are mostly in Muqdadiyah, Khanaqeen, and Baaquba.

Key needs:

- Houses rehabilitation/reconstruction(

370 houses, 35 partial damage, and more than 300 houses are completely damaged and burned)

- Livelihood --- ICRC distributed more than 110 livelihood grants and planning to distribute for the rest of the returned 180 families.

Ninewa Update

Humanitarian Assistance– MOMD Update

- **800 food boxes** were distributed in **Mosul** to returnees from various camps in July, including Al Amal camp and KRI camps.
- In **Sinjar**, MOMD supported returnees from KRI camps across multiple areas:
 - Sinjar District
 - Sinuni Sub-District
 - Qayrawan Sub-District
 - Qahtanyah Sub-District
- **Items distributed in Sinjar included:**
 - 1,250 food boxes
 - 1,250 hygiene kits
 - 1,250 kitchen tool sets
- **Total families assisted: 2,500 families** between June and July.

Compensation Update

Compensation of west Ninewa

Overall Progress (2017 – July 2025)

- Total files submitted in West Ninewa: 64,000 (since 2017)
- Files submitted from 2021 to July 2025: 50,000

Status of files submitted:

- 26,000 approved by Ninewa Court of Appeal (awaiting payment)
- 12,000 pending approval
- 8,000 under registration
- 4,000 received compensation
- No change since last update (before June 2025) – limited processing June–July 2025

Sinjar District:

- Total files completed: 23,000
- Files under registration: 8,000

Qahtaniyah Sub-District (Ba'aj-linked):

- Total files completed: 7,000
- Files under registration: 2,000

Recommendation Letters Issued (June–July 2025)

| Area | Families with Recommendation Letters |

Distribution timeline

- Last distribution round: October 2024
- Next distribution dates remain unchanged

Summary of June–July 2025 Progress

- No new approvals or payments by Court of Appeal or Ministry of Finance
- Progress limited to administrative steps (recommendation letters issued)
- 2,989 families moved closer to final compensation (referred to judge)
- No change in total completed files in Sinjar or Qahtaniyah
