

DS Update

DSTF Meeting Highlights -June 25, 2026

- **Shift to a development-led approach:** The official phasing out of the Humanitarian Coordinator (HC) role was announced, signaling a permanent shift toward long-term development. Peter Hawkins was introduced as the Interim Resident Coordinator effective July, and a new quarterly meeting schedule for the DSTF was established to ensure that progress on the displacement file is maintained.
- **Update on the Sinjar Investment and Development Plan (UNDP):** The PM-led Sinjar Investment and Development Plan (SIDP) was outlined, highlighting a shift toward long-term development, a blended financing model, and UNDP's role as an integrator to formulate a comprehensive, costed strategy.
- **Update on DS/IDP Data Workstream (IOM):** Updates were provided on the decline in IDP numbers, the 2026 data roadmap, FVM outcomes, and the launch of the joint GIZ/IOM Activity Info platform.
- **Update on Housing and Compensation (UN-Habitat):** Updates were provided on the digitization of the compensation system, the BEIT green housing project, land title distribution for Yazidis, and a legislative roadmap for housing reform.
- **Perspectives on Advocacy Approaches (Donors/UK):** A refreshed advocacy strategy was presented by the UK on behalf of donors, emphasizing government ownership and a tiered priority system to reframe durable solutions as an economic and security opportunity.

Launch of ActivityInfo Platform for Durable Solutions

- **Platform Objective:** A centralized tool to consolidate interventions across all governorates, enabling the partners to identify coverage gaps and track progress against Strategic Objectives.
- **Data Status:** The platform currently hosts historical data from **Q2, Q3, and Q4 of 2025**.
- **Dashboards:** Interactive views are live, allowing users to explore:
 - Geographical distribution of activities.
 - Outputs reported under specific strategic objectives and indicators.

Current Priority: Q1 2026 Reporting

- The reporting window for **January – March 2026** is now officially OPEN.
- All partners are encouraged to submit data to ensure accurate collective planning.
